



Thanks for being part of 24 Hours of Prayer. As we listen for God's voice and seek Him in faith, we believe He'll respond in amazing ways. Below are 24 suggestions to help guide our time. Pray a sentence or two for each topic or focus on just a few as the Spirit leads. We're excited to see how God will move!

GATHER

1. Thank the Lord for His mercy that is new again every day. Give praise to the Father, Son and Holy Spirit. Declare God's goodness and grace—more than enough for today and for eternity.
2. Seek the Lord's blessing and favor for our Ark Valley Correctional Facility campus, for the men who attend, serve and lead there in this difficult season.
3. Pray that God will move through Woodmen Easter services, on-campus, on TV and online. Ask that lives would be changed and Christ's name be lifted up this Easter and in the days to come.
4. In this challenging year, ask the Lord to give wisdom to Woodmen pastors, elders, deacons and leaders to direct and care for people with integrity, skill and courage to the glory of God.
5. Pray that God will provide as we give generously. We're trusting Him for a new church home for our Monument campus, so we can better serve and reach people in the Tri-Lakes region.
6. Thank God for all the ways people can worship Him today, from online services to Huddles, from underground churches to auditoriums and cathedrals, let His name be praised across the earth.

CONNECT

7. Pray that as Easter approaches, God will provide the people of Woodmen opportunities to invite friends to celebrate with us, whether on-campus or at home, and to share our faith in Jesus.
8. Pray that children and teens in our city will discover Jesus. Ask God to pour out His life-changing redemption for young people who are longing for truth and light in the darkness.
9. Call out to God to heal many who are hurting today. For those who are suffering from COVID-19, ask the Lord to cure completely, to breathe His wholeness into their lives.
10. Ask for God's mercy to rain down on people in our city who need hope today—on those with special needs, those who are oppressed, alone, addicted, without homes, mentally ill or hungry.
11. Pray that the Holy Spirit will empower and embolden us to walk in our primary calling as a church: to make disciples of Jesus.
12. Thank God for His nearness and goodness over the last year—for the ways He's guided and sustained the people of Woodmen to love well in homes, huddles and across El Paso County.

GROW

13. Pray that through Easter services at Woodmen, we would hold fast to the gospel of Christ. That we would center our lives around His life, death, burial, resurrection and coming return.
14. Ask the Holy Spirit to give us a hunger to consistently study and understand the Bible and to clearly, gracefully and confidently communicate God's truths to a questioning culture.
15. Thank God for Jesus, the only name that saves. Let us be united around the timeless message of the gospel and not be divided by manmade traditions, ideologies or trends.
16. Pray that the thousands of people in Woodmen Community Groups will build lasting, authentic relationships as they study God's Word and encourage each other to become more like Christ.
17. Ask God to replace our fears with His perfect love. Knowing that we stand on a firm foundation, let us offer courtesy and respect to those with whom we disagree, and by so doing bring glory to God.

CONTRIBUTE

18. Thank God for those who give faithfully to Kingdom work at Woodmen, fueling ministry and welcoming others to experience the hope of the gospel.
19. Seek God's protection and grace for health care workers, teachers and other front-line workers in our city and for their families.
20. Pray that even in a pandemic, our global mission partners will find good and grace-filled ways to minister to those in need. Lift up the work in Estonia and the ministry of Cure International, ELIC, Empart, Compassion International and more.
21. As our friends at Proclamation Church in Nashville prepare for their launch on Easter Sunday, ask the Lord to be present and to unite the hearts of this new fellowship of believers.
22. Ask the Lord to bless local schools, food pantries and ministry partners, including Safe Families, Life Network and Springs Rescue Mission, as they care for people across the Pikes Peak region.
23. Pray that we will continue to spread hope, justice and mercy as we serve our neighbors and meet tangible needs through Woodmen ACTS.
24. From greeting guests, to holding babies to worship and tech, ask God to empower us to love well and change lives through Christ as we serve week-in, week-out across Woodmen campuses.
