KEY VERSE:

WORSHIP

MAKE: Joy To The World!

Help each baby create a memorable craft to remember the lesson

SUPPLIES:

- Joy craft card
- Yellow stamp pad or paint
- Paintbrush



DIRECTIONS:

Gently press the baby's hand into the stamp pad or brush it with paint. Press their hand onto the top of the page with fingers pointing downward to create a "star." Clean the child's hand with a wipe or wash in the sink.

SAY:

"Look at your handprint! It looks like a star. See the manger? God sent Jesus to the Earth to save us. Jesus is our Gift!"

BLESSING: May you someday know Jesus as your savior. God's gift for the world!

PLAY: Pin the Star above the Barn!

SUPPLIES: Manger Poster and stars

DIRECTIONS:

Tape the manger scene to the wall. Give each child a star and help them take turns placing it above the scene. Repeat as many times as desired. For younger babies, you can do the activity while holding them and narrating what you're doing.

SAY:

"Look at the star. It guided the wisemen to find where Jesus was. They brought Him gifts. They knew He was sent to be our Savior. Jesus is God's gift."

PLAY: Nativity Playset!

SUPPLIES: Nativity Playset

DIRECTIONS:

Lay the nativity set out and let the children hold and explore the pieces. Explain who each piece represents. You can even narrate the story using the pieces. Point out the little baby Jesus figure.

SAY:

"Wow you are holding baby Jesus. God sent Jesus into the world to be our Savior!"
