

Summer Camp HOSTS Frequently Asked Questions

WILL I NEED COMPUTER ACCESS FOR CAMP?

Yes. All of the daily lesson content is provided in video format on our website. While there will be time to take breaks and pause the videos, access to a tv, computer, iPad, phone, or other device with internet is required to participate in camp.

HOW DO I ACCESS ALL THE CAMP VIDEO LESSONS?

Each day, a new daily video lesson will be posted by 7am at woodmenvalley.org/spaceblast. You can use a computer, TV or even an iPad to show these videos, but we highly encourage you to access the video and test it before your participants arrive.

ARE THERE DIFFERENT OPTIONS FOR DIFFERENT AGES?

Parents were given an option of age range when they registered: Kinder and Younger or 1st Grade and Older. All of the lessons and activities are the same, there are just some simple modifications for each age group, including the craft. If your group has kids in both age ranges, it should still be easy for them to follow along and participate as a group. Just note that there are two different craft instructions included in the video so you may want to skip those instructions and lead that time on your own or allow each age group to watch their corresponding instructions.

WILL WOODMEN KIDS ASSIGN OTHER KIDS TO MY GROUP?

We will only contact you if there are people in your area looking for a host and if you stated on your Host registration that you have room for more kids to join. If we do connect you with a family that wants to join your group, it is then your responsibility to communicate all details with that family directly. We hope to connect all families by June 1st.

ARE PARENTS REQUIRED TO STAY?

It's up to you to decide what your expectations are for your camp! If you'd like to require parents to stay with their child each day, please communicate directly to the parents in your group. You are responsible for all communications and logistics!

WHAT IF I WANT TO PROVIDE BREAKFAST OR LUNCH FOR MY GROUP?

Again, you are responsible for all the details of your camp. Woodmen Kids is simply providing the lesson content for you to execute how you'd like. It is your responsibility to coordinate these details with the families you're hosting. If you do decide to provide meals, please be considerate of allergies and dietary restrictions and provide detailed info to families about these provided meals.

HOW DOES CAMP WORK? IS THERE A SCHEDULE?

You can choose to participate in the content at whatever speed works best for your group, but we estimate it will take about 3 hours to complete each day's lesson. Throughout the videos,

your group will have a chance to participate in each activity using materials provided in their camp bag. You can pause the video whenever you need to allow time to finish each activity.

WHAT IF SOMEONE WANTS TO BRING A FRIEND?

Just like the old school Backyard Bible Clubs – this is a great way to bring Jesus into our neighborhoods and connect with those around us! If someone hears about your camp and wants to join last minute, that's ok! We will contact you on the best way to get the supplies to you/them!

WILL I NEED ANY OTHER SUPPLIES?

Every child's bag includes prepared materials and supplies they need to participate in camp including crafts, snacks, missions supplies and more. Some of our crafts do involve paint and snack time could get a little messy, so we do suggest you prepare your areas by putting down tablecloths or other protective items. You may also want to have paper towels, wet wipes and other cleaning materials handy!

WHAT ARE THE FACEBOOK CHALLENGES & LIVE VIDEOS?

Each day of the week, there will be some type of optional challenge or activity for kids to participate in. Specific details will be explained in the daily videos as well as the "Daily Wrap Up" pages in the participant booklet, but we hope your group will join us in participating!
