## TODDLERS, PRESCHOOL & ELEMENTARY

### NOVEMBER 2 & 3

**LESSON TOPIC:** The Burning Bush  
**PASSAGE:** Exodus 3:1-12

**LESSON GOAL:** God cares so much about His people that he can rescue us in unexpected ways. It doesn't always make it easy, but He wants us to trust Him.

**GOD STATEMENT:** God Rescues

### NOVEMBER 9 & 10

**LESSON TOPIC:** The Ten Plagues  
**PASSAGE:** Exodus 7:1-7

**LESSON GOAL:** God is all powerful and delivers His people when they are in trouble

**GOD STATEMENT:** God Is Deliverer

### NOVEMBER 16 & 17

**LESSON TOPIC:** Moses Parts the Red Sea  
**PASSAGE:** Exodus 14

**LESSON GOAL:** Even in times of fear or uncertainty, God has a plan because He is in control.

**GOD STATEMENT:** God Is In Control

### NOVEMBER 23 & 24

**LESSON TOPIC:** The Ten Commandments  
**PASSAGE:** Exodus 20:1-21

**LESSON GOAL:** God gives us rules and guidelines because He loves us and wants to show us how to live, how to honor God and how to show respect to others.

**GOD STATEMENT:** God Is Our Guide

### NOVEMBER 30 & DECEMBER 1

**LESSON TOPIC:** Remember & Celebrate  
**PASSAGE:** Review Genesis & Exodus

**LESSON GOAL:** Reflect on all the things we have to be thankful for and the way God has been working in our lives over the last several months.



### IN THE MORNING:

November is a great month to get into the habit of gratitude and thankfulness. Before the busyness of the day kicks in, spend a couple minutes as a family taking turns sharing what you are thankful for. Then, spend time in prayer thanking God for what you just shared.



### IN THE CAR:

God is in control. As you are in the car driving, take turns focusing on this truth about God by sharing different statements and truths of God being in control (ie. "God is in control when I'm sad," "God is in control when I'm happy," "God is in control when...").



### DURING DINNER:

While food is cooking, spend time as a family making placemats for your meal. Gather paper and art supplies then write or draw what you're thankful for. Use these placemats as you enjoy your meal and share with each other what you wrote or drew.



### IN THE EVENING:

As you wind down for the night, think of a person or family going through a tough time during this holiday season. Think of ways you can show up for that person and help make them feel loved and seen. Then spend time praying for them.

### ACTIVITIES

*Play these fun activities with your child*

#### WALK THE RIVER MAZE

Use blue scarves, blankets, tape or other materials to make a river maze on the floor. Have the children follow the maze to the end. They can tip-toe, crawl, hop, etc.

**SAY:** "Remember, when Moses was a baby, he floated on the river. God protected him and kept him safe. He is our protector."

#### PEEL THE LEAVES

Tape a contact paper sheet to the wall (sticky side out). Place foam leaves on the sticky part. Encourage the children to remove and re-stick the leaves.

**SAY:** "When Moses grew up, God spoke to him through a bush that was on fire. Take the leaves off the wall and put them back on. The leaves look red like fire. God used the burning bush to speak to Moses. God used Moses to free the people of Israel. Can we free the leaves from the wall?"

### READ OVER YOUR CHILD

*Read this prayer, verse & blessing over your child throughout the month*

#### PRAYER

"Thank you for keeping us safe and protecting us every day. I can have peace because you are our protector. Amen."

#### VERSE

"Moses answered the people. He said, 'Don't be afraid. Stand firm. You will see how the Lord will save you today. Do you see those Egyptians? You will never see them again. The Lord will fight for you. Just be still.'"

#### BLESSING

"May you remember that when you feel uncertain or fearful, God is always with you. Turn to Him for comfort; He is our protector."
