The internship helps interns discern a potential call to ministry, while the residency focuses on gaining clarity and specialized development in a specific ministry area.

As valued team members, both roles also receive intentional, caring support and guidance as they engage with coaches and mentors, participate in weekly leadership classes, offer and receive direct feedback and dedicate time to investing in and deepening their relationship with God through the program!

JOB FUNCTION

4. Timely weekly follow-up with attenders in answering questions and helping them get connected.

7. Host at the Woodmen welcome to help people feel valued and loved.
8. Other duties as assigned.
